Don't Do This

Don't sell non-compliant foods and beverages, this violates GCSS board policy EE.

Examples of non-compliant fundraising includes the sale of:

Candy, cookies, popcorn, sodas made with sugar, sweetened coffee, hot chocolate, cup noodles, energy drinks, and donuts for on-campus consumption

Fast food - including biscuits & other items sold in the car rider line or in the school building.

Host a "Taste of the Town" Event

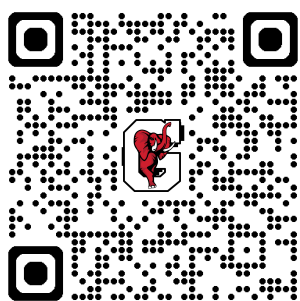
Invite local chefs to donate healthy dishes
