#### Obion County Schools Adds Additional School Resource Officer

Obion County Schools has utilized Safe Schools grant funds to bring an additional school resource officer onto campuses for the 2021-2022 school year. Johnathan Reyna has become Obion County's Sergeant over the School Resource Officer Program with an office at Obion County Central. While being housed at Obion County Central, Sergeant Reyna acts in a supervisory capacity for all the SROs employed within our schools. Additionally, his presence decreases the likelihood that schools will be without an SRO as he is able to step in if a school-assigned officer must be out for sickness, training, or court dates. Sergeant Reyna also adds to the positive relationship that exists between Obion County Schools and the Obion County Sheriff's Department and Sheriff Karl Jackson. Our school system is deeply appreciative of the work of all our school resource officers and is excited about the positive things our officers do for our students. 


