


Students in 1st through 5th grade met their typical growth!

iReady Mathematics Data 2023-2024




Students in 1st through 5th grade met their typical growth!



CheckPoint - How are the inaugural Dual Language Students performing in Spanish?

★ NEW in 2023-24:

- 63 Grade 6 Dual Language Students were assessed with the Avant STAMP 4Se and scored using the ACTFL Proficiency Scale
- This is the equivalent of the Avant STAMP 4S exam that our Juniors & Seniors take to attain the Seal of Biliteracy
- Students are assessed in the 4 language domains:
 - Listening
 - Speaking
 - Reading
 - Writing


















New Jersey Student Learning Assessments DATA






