Title: Lead Nurse (Level 5 Stipend Position)

Reports to: Supervisor of Student Services

Position Summary: The Lead Nurse assists departmental and school administration in the dissemination of vital information and coordination of department medical/health projects. The Lead Nurse also serves as a resource to district nurses and helps promote consistency of nursing services throughout the district.

Qualifications:

- 1. Certification as School Nurse (RN);
- 2. A minimum of three (3) years of experience as a school nurse in district;
- 3. Ability to work effectively with department staff, school administration, and other members of the school community;
- 4. Knowledge of district, county, and state guidelines and regulations for health services;
- 5. Strong interpersonal skills, problem solving skills, and communication skills;
- 6. Ability to multi-task;
- 7. Other qualifications to be determined by the Superintendent of Schools.

Duties:

- 1. Consults with School Physician as needed.
- 2. Promotes consistent nursing procedures across the district.
- 3. Serves as liaison to Middlesex County Health Department.
- 4. Serves as mentor for newly hired nurses to the district.
- 5. Participates in interviews for substitute nurses and school nurses.
- 6. Assists in the updating of the nurses manual and Board Policies on a yearly basis.
- 7. Identifies and assists with training needs of staff for future staff development sessions.
- 8. Performs other duties as many be assigned by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
