The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has issued guidance stating that HVAC systems are one component of maintaining healthy school environments, and is an important COVID-19 prevention strategy for schools. Ensuring heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems are properly functioning is integral to this objective. Forty-two (42) new roof-top units will replace existing unit ventilators that are beyond their useful life. New ductwork will be installed in the classrooms to facilitate air distribution and circulation.

How the LEA will use the funds it reserves under section 2001(e)(1) of the ARP Act to address the academic impact of lost instructional time through the implementation of evidence-based interventions, such as summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day, comprehensive afterschool programs, or extended school year; ([count] of 2000 maximum characters used)

EBPS will monitor at-risk students at the district, school, and classroom levels to ensure we are meeting the needs of all learners, particularly those students disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Currently, 42 high school classrooms require improvements to HVAC systems as the existing systems are antiquated. The COVID-19 pandemic and the need to provide properly functioning HVAC systems is critical to maintaining safe and healthy environments.
