SCHOOL COUNSELOR

The school counselor can offer monthly check-ins with students, or short-term support (six consecutive sessions) with things like: school anxiety, friendship and social skills, emotions, grief, and attendance. Please email the counselor or fill out a permission form to have the counselor work with your student.

INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT SOCIAL WORKER

Our school social worker, Sophia, can meet with students weekly for 12-18 weeks about: traumatic events, grief, incarcerated family member, disordered eating, self harm, suicidal ideation, substance use, and/or experiencing homelessness.

INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT ODYSSEY HOUSE

Our district has partnered with Odyssey House to provide long-term counseling supports to elementary students through telehealth. You can find out more by looking up Odyssey House on the district website or here.



COUNSELING GOAL

Help meet the social, emotional and mental health needs of all students so they can access their education, through individual therapeutic support, group work, and school-wide SEL supports.

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Classroom Lessons

The school counselor teaches monthly lessons about topics that are applicable to all students, including:

- Bullying, harassment, and discrimination
- Emotional regulation
- Problem-solving
- · College and Career

These lessons will include various instructional videos and children's books.
