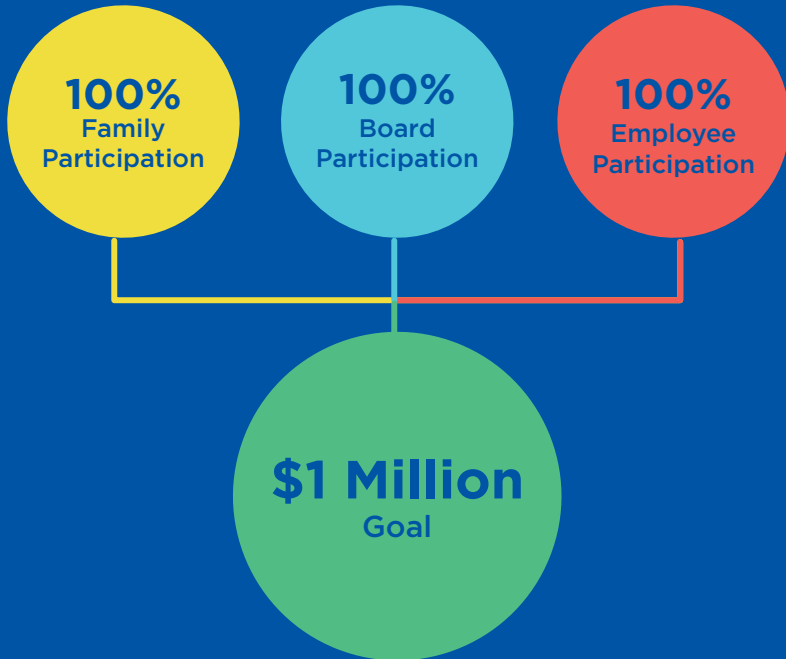




OUR 2024-25 GOALS

Because tuition only covers **90%** of our operating expenses, we depend on The Eagles Fund to provide essential financial support to power our mission.

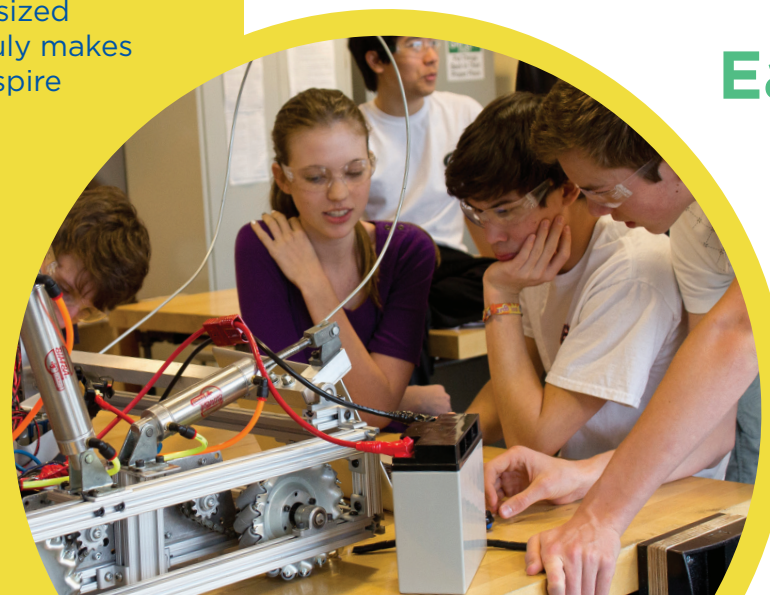


AIS was founded by the generosity of our parents and friends. We count on you to continue this tradition of giving.
