We are excited to have you at FWCS! The FWCS Technology team is committed to supporting your student's learning by providing instructional technology tools and resources. We believe technology can be used to accelerate student learning when used intentionally and we can't wait to see all your student achieves! In this welcome information you will find some key information about supporting your student throughout the year with technology.

## Student Devices

Students in grades 9-12 will receive a PC Laptop or Chromebook, depending on their school. This device will be assigned to your student and utilized each year.



Student devices allow students to continue their learning even when they are away from school.

Students will be bringing their devices home daily in their designated bags. Please ensure that they are charged fully each night and ready for learning the next day. This will also allow students to be prepared in the event of an eLearning or Remote Learning day designated by the district.

At home, Laptops should be taken out of their bags when students are using them to learn. Always carry the device by two hands and away from food and drink. When not using your device keep them in a safe and secure location. inside the bag.

Student devices are filtered and monitored to ensure student safety at home and at school.

## Classroom/Remote Days

**Synchronous Learning**  
learning that takes place in the same space, at the same time, this can happen over zoom!

## eLearning

**Asynchronous Learning**  
learning that takes place at the learners pace on the learners time

## eLearning

- students are expected to login to Schoology to view instructions & assignments
- required to complete all work assigned
- attendance is based on turning in work by the end of the 3rd day
- teachers will hold office hours for student questions



## Remote Learning

- students engage in live, virtual instruction
- students must check in using the Google form for attendance
- Teachers will determine due dates for assignments
