

Moorpark High School Stadium CODE OF CONDUCT

STADIUM ENTRANCE

- Each individual must have valid ticket
- Each student must have an ID to enter stadium event
- All students in middle and elementary school must be accompanied by an adult
- There are no in-and-out privileges at the stadium. Once you exit the stadium, you may not re-enter

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Backpacks
- Items designed to be thrown
- Motorized vehicles, skateboards, scooters, or bicycles
- Devices or equipment that produce or amplify sound
- Alcohol / Tobacco / Cannabis / Controlled Substances
- Smoking or vaping devices
- Weapons of any kind including dangerous objects
- Filled beverage containers (empty ones are okay)
- Coolers (including soft sided coolers)
- Animals (service animals permitted)

PROHIBITED ACTIONS AND BEHAVIORS

- Loitering, standing, horseplay, or gathering in aisles, concourses, entrances, exits, and bathrooms
- Failing to follow instruction of school officials, law enforcement, and security personnel
 Profanity or other offensive language; spoken or appearing on apparel
- Mistreatment of others, including verbal abuse, harassment, profanity, confrontations, intimidation
- Fighting or other threatening, aggressive, disrespectful or defiant behavior
- Entering the playing area at any time
- Failure to identify one's self to school staff, security or law enforcement upon request
- Conduct that results in damage, destruction, vandalism, or theft of any property
- Individuals who have used alcohol / cannabis / controlled substance
- Violation of state or local laws

Code of Conduct Violations

- Any individual violating the Code of Conduct will be immediately removed from the stadium and must exit school property
- Individuals may be prohibited from attending future school events
