Current year Free/Reduced meal applications are available. Applications are required to be renewed annually and qualify based on new year income.

Information is available on our website at www.emmettschools.org, Facebook and Instagram.

We encourage families to read the Parent Letter that includes the Income Guidelines for each meal status.

For example a family of 4 can have a household income up to \$57,720 and qualify for reduced price meals.

This is a huge savings for family budgets.

Applications can be filled out anytime during the school year when there is a change in household income or additional family members, seasonal workers, layoff due to injury, or if company layoffs occur.
