All students at Roncalli Catholic High School are required to perform service each semester as a requirement for graduation. The purpose is to help students learn to imitate Christ by serving those in need and to develop the habit of service as Jesus taught us.

- **FRESHMEN AND SOPHOMORES ARE REQUIRED TO PERFORM A MINIMUM OF 5 HOURS EACH AND EVERY SEMESTER.**
- **JUNIORS AND SENIORS ARE REQUIRED TO PERFORM A MINIMUM OF 10 HOURS EACH AND EVERY SEMESTER.**
- **EXTRA HOURS DO NOT CARRY OVER TO THE NEXT SEMESTER.**
- **FULL CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN IF ALL HOURS ARE UP TO DATE!**
- **ONLY HOURS SERVED AFTER APRIL 19, 2024 ARE ACCEPTED.**
- **TURN-IN DATE FOR SUMMER/FALL HOURS IS DECEMBER 6, 2024.**
- **GRADE DEDUCTED 10% FOR EACH SCHOOL DAY LATE.**

ALL HOURS WILL BE INSCRIBED ON THE FINAL TRANSCRIPTS so that colleges and universities will be able to see the role of community service in the students' lives. This may be of assistance for scholarships and admissions.

Remember... Christian Service must be **NON-PAID** activities done for **NON-PROFIT** human service agencies and/or **NEEDY** individuals **OUTSIDE THE FAMILY**. Students may not count hours performed to meet other requirements (e.g., NHS, FEA, Building Pride, extra-curricular activities, confirmation, court orders, scouting, etc.).

Examples of **ACCEPTABLE** activities:

- visiting the elderly in nursing homes
- assisting with food drives
- working in soup kitchens
- mentoring underprivileged youth
- assisting with Sunday school
- church or parish events
- school development events
- pro-life activities
- Habitat for Humanity
- coaching/assisting at camps/clinics
- cleaning the neighborhood and/or parks
- working with neighborhood organizations
- some Roncalli activities (as announced)

UNACCEPTABLE activities:

- **SERVICE TO ANY FAMILY MEMBERS FOR ANY REASON**
- extra-curricular activities
- service done during a school day
- babysitting/dogsitting/housesitting for neighbors/relatives/non-needly
- tutoring students **OUTSIDE** a regulated program
- unpaid labor at a for-profit business, LIKE A DAY-CARE
- unpaid labor for **non-needly** individuals
- internships

- campaigning for political candidates
- service for organizations with contrary morals to Catholic teaching **INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:** American Diabetes Association, Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, Glaucoma Research Foundation, American Lung Association, American Association for Cancer Research, ALS Association, March of Dimes, Masons, Muscular Dystrophy Association, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, Parkinson's Action Network, Parkinson's Disease Foundation, National Spinal Cord Injury Association, National Multiple Sclerosis Society, National Hemophilia Foundation, National Ataxia Foundation, the Nebraska Ataxia Foundation, St. Jude Research Hospital, Shriners, and the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation
