We would like to request 3 printers, which would be housed in the instructional coaches' offices to offset the cost of pages per print. ➤ The cost per printer is \$734.25. ➤ Proposal #2 (\$647.76) – Office Guest Chairs- To refresh the office to house and host parents and stakeholders while handling school business. ➤ The cost per chair- \$161.94 ➤ Proposal #3 (\$7885.00) Blinds for the Cafe- To increase our safety measurements in the school especially in common areas like the cafeteria. ➤ Proposal #4 (\$1300) – Staff Appreciation Gifts-As a means of providing a nice experience for the teachers, the school would like to request additional funding to support the activities and items in honor of Teacher Appreciation Week. ➤ Proposal #5 (\$3510) – Student T-shirts- To assist with uniformity of the students and to increase our safety efforts while traveling away from the school (field trips and school events). The school would like to purchase shirts for each student. The shirts would be housed at the school and the school will determine the methods for laundering the shirts. ➤ The cost for each shirt is \$5.85 with the hope of purchasing 600 shirts. The over amount will support the transit rate of students throughout the year. ➤ Proposal #6 (\$179) – T-shirt Press Machine- To assist with uniformity of the students and school branding.
