#### **Mastery in Math**


Students who receive an 85 or higher on 3 Math Regents Exams will receive a Mastery In Math notation on their diploma

Exams will receive a Mastery In Science notation on their
diploma

Students who wish to retake a Regents Exam for a higher score MUST speak with their counselor to sign up for the exam ASAP Regents Exams are available in January/June/August






# The College Admissions Essay



## Application Follow-Through for Students


Contact colleges regarding your application status

Student sends all AP Scores that you want the school to have. (collegeboard.org)


- **Student** sends transcripts from colleges where Dual Enrollment credits were purchased.

### **FAFSA**

(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

Free application to be filled out by all families who want to apply for Financial Aid/Scholarships

The application opens October 1st and must be completed every year!
