

**Memorandum of Agreement
Between
Snoqualmie Valley Education Association
and
The Snoqualmie Valley School District
RE: Contract Modifications for the 2024-25 School Year**

The Snoqualmie Valley School District (District) and the Snoqualmie Valley Education Association (Association) enter into the following agreement.

1. A certificated staff member traveling between CKMS and TFMS will be provided with a \$2400 stipend per semester as compensation for travel time during their planning. The employee will also be reimbursed at the IRS rate for mileage between the buildings.
2. With the move of the elementary Parent Partnership Program (P3) to Snoqualmie Elementary School (SES), SES specialists will provide specialist services to P3 students. SES and P3 administrators and SES specialists will collaborate on the grade configurations for the specialist time. SES specialists will not be assigned more P3 students to instruct at one time than the number of students indicated in Section 38.1 of the CBA for elementary class size relief. This is a second-year pilot for the 2024-25 school year and will be reviewed at MIC.

This Memorandum of Agreement remains in place until the last day of the 2024-2025 school year or until superseded by another MoA, whichever comes first.
