If a student has never taken a college level academic course while in high school, please be advised the student will be required to take the TSI Assessment prior to the enrollment in any academic courses/certificates/degrees once the student has graduated and/or completed high school. Although exemption is the language used for Level One certificates (L1 Cert) to support the enrollment process please be advised a student will be responsible to meet the TSI requirements if the student was to enroll into a course that was not in alignment with the program plan of the L1 Cert degree (As per policy) 05/2018
