Application Process:

- Obtain one letter of recommendation. The letter of recommendation must be from a high school teacher from whom you took a class so he or she can address your academic potential and achievements.
- Submit a personal essay.

The scholarship will be awarded based on quality of application and how well the applicant meets criteria.
