Music Department Scholarship Eligibility
Scholarship applications are considered for graduating students who intend to continue their studies in music or related arts at a college or university with a four-year program for such majors. Students who apply for this scholarship must attach proof of acceptance to the program before the scholarship is presented and must attend such program beginning with the fall semester after graduation. Areas of music and related arts majors are: Instrumental or Vocal Music, Music Education, Music Therapy, Theatre Arts (Music), Music Composition, Music Theory, Music History, Music Recording, Dance, Music Industry, or other related programs that are accepted by the committee.
The Rydzeski's Scholarship Eligibility
Students applying for this scholarship must be outstanding musician, a role model for other student musicians and an active member of the music program. If possible, applicant should have participated in multiple performing groups (curricular and extra-curricular) and the high school musical. Applicant should be of good character, reliable and trustworthy. Majoring in music in college is not a requirement. Students who apply for this scholarship must attach proof of acceptance to a four-year program before the scholarship is presented and must attend such program beginning with the fall semester after graduation.
Awards The scholarships will consist of cash awards. The amounts of these awards will vary according to funds available and the number of scholarships awarded by the committee.
