
Lunch and Recess

Registration!



Here is what the process will look like for families:

Family Pre Registration Instruction

Paperwork that we need brought to the school:

- Residency paperwork can be uploaded OR bring it to school
- Original Birth Certificates
- Updated physical (within the year of the first day of school)

*Bus orientation


*Parent orientation and Anti-Bullying Workshop





Screening Process


- All Kindergarten students will be screened in the spring.
- The purpose of screening is to identify your child's readiness skills.



Getting Ready for Kindergarten How Families can Help



- READ with your child
- Encourage independence at home
- READ with your child
- Have children practice coloring, cutting, gluing
- READ with children. Have them hold the book and turn the pages
- Practice writing first and last name
- READ with your child



Please Remember....

Full-day kindergarten is an adjustment for every child.

Your child may present as more tired than usual, appear dysregulated, seem overly emotional when they get home, or even have new behaviors.

Give your child a chance to settle into their new schedule and longer school day. You may want to consider keeping a slower paced schedule at home with downtime.

After 6-8 week of Kindergarten, if your child hasn't adjusted to the new routine and schedule, you may want to reach out to your child's classroom teacher



CORI

- A CORI is a Criminal Offender Record Information Acknowledgement Form
- In order to volunteer at Sippican you must complete a CORI
- The office will need to take a copy of your license to complete the form
- You are welcome to complete this form when you come to finish your registration or any other time you are at our office
