# SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION REPORT

# July 10, 2024

### **Capital Projects Under Construction**

#### **Career and Technology Center Improvements**

<u>Project Description</u>: The current Career & Technology Center building was designed for only 380 students in 19 programs and currently houses over 800 students in 24 programs per semester. This project constructs 108,205 sf of additions with select demolition and renovation work for the existing facility while maintaining complete program instruction.

<u>Work to Commence</u>: June 2020 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 2024 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

- Building Maintenance Classroom and Lab Electrical and plumbing rough-ins are ongoing. Completion of this space is expected late July.
- Demolition of the 1987 Addition is complete.
- Parking lot work is underway. Original site lighting conduit was found to be shallow and will require to be replaced at a lower elevation. Sitework Contractor and Construction Manager are expediting work to maintain project schedule.
- Contractors will be completing corridor ceilings and epoxy floors during the summer break.

### Westminster East Middle School Replacement

<u>Project Description</u>: The former East Middle School building was 120,400 square feet and was renovated in 1976. The original building was constructed in 1936 and received additions in 1941, 1950, and 1964. The existing local functional capacity of the school includes 750 regular education seats and 40 special education seats to house the Behavioral Support Team (BEST) students. The replacement school will provide a modern facility that addresses the requirements of the current middle school program and supports 21<sup>st</sup>-century learning environments. Work to Commence: Fall 2021

Scheduled Completion: Phase I (School Bldg.) Summer 2023, Phase II (Bus Loop) Spring 2024

Recent Activity:

- Phase II work is ongoing.
- Guard Rails have been installed along Tuc Road and the Bus Loop Driveway.
- Guard Rail Fencing at retaining walls will start at the beginning of July.
- Temporary Construction fencing is being removed and landscaping is ongoing.

• The Final surface paving at Tuc Road and Longwell Ave. will be complete at the end of June. Final Paving at the bus loop will be completed by the middle of July.

### **Oklahoma Road Middle School HVAC Replacement**

<u>Project Description</u>: HVAC Replacement for entire school. <u>Work to Commence</u>: April 03, 2024 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 15, 2025 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

- Phase I interior construction scheduled to start June 17,2024 and be completed August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Admin. and summertime staff to remain onsite during phase I interior construction.
- Admin. and summertime staff will also remain onsite during phase II of the interior construction (summer 2025). They will be relocated to an area completed in phase I while the main office area is completed during Phase II.
- Approximately 60 % of the school will be completed during phase I.
- Approximately 40 % of the school will be completed during phase II.

# **Mount Airy Elementary School HVAC Replacement**

<u>Project Description</u>: HVAC Replacement for entire school. <u>Work to Commence</u>: April 22, 2024 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 15, 2025 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

- Phase I interior construction scheduled to start June 17,2024 and be completed August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Admin. and summertime staff to be relocated to Parrs Ridge the week of June 17<sup>th</sup> – June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024, and will be returning week of August 5<sup>th</sup> – August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Admin. and summertime staff will remain onsite during phase II of the interior construction (summer 2025) and will be relocated to the media center while the main office area is completed.
- Approximately 20 % of the school will be completed during phase I.
- Approximately 80 % of the school will be completed during phase II.
- The phases are unbalanced due to the majority of the equipment not being available until after September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

### **Roof Replacements**

<u>Project Description</u>: Roof Replacements at Spring Garden Elementary School and North Carroll Middle School <u>Work to Commence</u>: June 19, 2024 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 18, 2024 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

• Work is underway on schedule at both schools.

# **Paving Replacements**

<u>Project Description</u>: Parking lot and associated road replacements at Mechanicsville Elementary, Runnymede Elementary, Northwest Middle and FSK High (lower lot & bus loop) <u>Work to Commence</u>: June 17, 2024 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 16, 2024 Recent Activity:

• Work is underway at Northwest Middle and Francis Scott Key High schools.

### **Relocatable Classroom Placement**

<u>Project Description</u>: Installation of One (1) Double Classroom Portable from Career & Technology Center to Sandymount Elementary School <u>Work to Commence</u>: June 17, 2024 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 16, 2024 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

• Work is underway for a summer completion.

# **Capital Projects in Planning & Design**

#### **Carroll Springs School HVAC Replacement**

<u>Project Description</u>: HVAC Replacement for entire school. <u>Work to Commence</u>: April 15, 2025 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 15, 2025 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

• The State declined funding under the Healthy Schools Facility Fund in June. The project will be placed on hold until State funding becomes available.

#### **Kindergarten Additions**

<u>Project Description</u>: Design Services for Kindergarten and Pre-K Additions at Friendship Valley Elementary, Cranberry Station Elementary, Sandymount Elementary and Taneytown Elementary Schools. Friendship Valley is also planned to receive a PRIDE regional program addition which brings the students from the portable into the building for better support and additional space. <u>Work to Commence</u>: June 15, 2025 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: August 15, 2026 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

- The State is now reviewing the Design Development (DD)documents.
- The design team is now in the Construction Documents (CD) phase.

#### Sykesville Middle School Capacity Addition

<u>Project Description</u>: This project includes the design and construction of additional capacity for Sykesville Middle School to accommodate projected enrollments. The preliminary scope of this project includes 2 additions and is based on Option B from the Sykesville Middle School Addition Feasibility Study. One addition will provide 10 new classrooms that will increase the school's capacity from 720 to 970. The second addition will provide additional related arts classrooms needed to accommodate the middle school schedule for 970 students. The final scope will be determined once an architect is hired, and the Construction Planning Committee is formed.

<u>Work to Commence</u>: June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: September 1st, 2028 <u>Recent Activity</u>:

• Construction Planning Committee meetings are underway to develop the Educational Specifications for the project which is the guiding scope for the hired architect.

• The recommendation for contract award to the architect will be presented to the Board of Education at the July 10, 2024 meeting.

### Freedom Elementary School Capacity & Pre-k Addition

<u>Project Description</u>: This project includes the design and construction of additional capacity for Freedom Elementary School to accommodate projected enrollments. The preliminary scope of this project is based on Option A from the Freedom Elementary School Addition Feasibility Study, and includes 1 Prekindergarten classroom and 4 general classrooms. The final scope will be determined once an architect is hired, and the Construction Planning Committee is formed. <u>Work to Commence</u>: June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026 <u>Scheduled Completion</u>: September 1st, 2027

Recent Activity:

- Construction Planning Committee meetings are underway to develop the Educational Specifications for the project which is the guiding scope for the hired architect.
- The recommendation for contract award to the architect will be presented to the Board of Education at the July 10, 2024 meeting.

### **Pre-K Additions**

Project Description: The project is meant to address the expansion of prekindergarten services for all 3- and 4-year-olds required by the Blueprint for Maryland's Future legislation. Carroll County Public Schools served 472 prekindergarten students at 20 elementary schools in 2023. New eligibility criteria required by the Blueprint for Maryland's Future legislation will mean that there is a significant increase in the number of eligible families. However, since prekindergarten will remain voluntary, it is difficult to project how many additional students will need to be served. Another complicating factor is that the Blueprint for Maryland's Future envisions that both public and private prekindergarten programs will serve eligible families. Due to the complicated public/private partnership structure and voluntary nature of the program, it is difficult to project how many additional students will need to be served in our schools. The current projections assume the prekindergarten enrollment will increase to 850 students by the year 2029. In order to accommodate this projected increase, additions are planned to be constructed at 15 elementary schools in three phases. Design for the Phase One additions are scheduled to begin in FY 2025.
