



School Colors: Black, White, Nelson Logo Gold, Khaki

- You may wear clothing that is made up of these colors. You may wear patterns that include the 4 school colors only.
- You may wear "Spirit Wear" that you have purchased from Nelson Academy or have been given as part of a reward or club membership.

Uniform Policy

Nelson Academy maintains high standards for dress and enforces the uniform policy every day. The following guidelines are in alignment with LBUSD uniform expectations. In any case that a student's attire is questionable, the student will be referred to an administrator for approval or to change into appropriate uniform clothing (i.e., a "loaner" will be provided). "Loaner" uniforms must be returned to the school at the end of the day. If they are not returned, a fine will be added to the student's record. In cases of economic hardship, help in obtaining uniforms is available.

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- All shorts and skirts must extend past the fingertips when arms are extended and shoulders are down to be considered an appropriate length.

 All uniform bottoms must be worn at the waist level/above the hips (no sagging). No underwear or skin should be exposed while the student is performing normal daily functions. The entire backside should be covered when a student is performing normal daily functions.

Outerwear

 All outerwear (windbreakers, sweaters, sweatshirts, etc.) must either be solid in color or a pattern of our school colors (black, white, khaki or school logo gold) and may contain Nelson logos.

Rain Gear

May be any color and will need to be removed once in the classroom.

Footwear / Hats / Accessories

- Shoes must have rubber soles and be closed-toed with toes covered by a durable material. Footwear should cover the entire foot starting at the ankle.
 Students must wear tennis shoes during PE each day.
- High heels, sandals, slippers, Crocs, or house shoes are NOT allowed.
- Hats and beanies must follow the district guidelines for sun protection and are worn only outside when
- the weather is appropriate. This includes hats being worn with the brim facing forward.
- . Hats, beanies, and hoods must be removed in the classroom.
- Earrings must be no larger than the size of a quarter and students can be instructed to remove earrings and any other jewelry for PE as a safety precaution.
- · Accessories NOT allowed include studded/sharp earrings/jewelry, chains, and bandanas.

NOT Allowed:

- . Colors other than those listed.
- Tank tops/exposed shoulders or bare midriffs. No part of the torso, stomach, belly area should be
 exposed while the student is performing normal daily functions.
- . No cut off shorts.
- . No rips/tears/ frayed clothing, even if there is cloth under the rip/tear/fray
- No "Compression" clothing (ie: yoga shorts/yoga pants/onesies)
- No pajama pants
- No references to or themes relating to:
 - = Sexual activity
 - Drugs/Alcohol/Dispensaries
 - Violence/ Aggressive Content
 - Disparagement of gender, race, or religion


1st Day of School






Sports and Event Attendance
