# "Why TVS Dance?"

### Families,

Thank you so much for considering TVS Dance programming as part of your child's experience here at Trinity Valley School. We offer robust programming in four major dance styles (ballet, lyrical, jazz, and hip hop) to students in Grades PreK-12. Broadly, our structure is as follows:

- PreK Dance, Kinder Dance = introductory programs
- Levels 1-2 = skill-building programs for Grades 1-4 in ballet / lyrical, jazz, and hip hop
- Level 3 = advanced skill-building programs for Grades 5-8 in ballet, lyrical, and jazz, while still inclusive of dancers seeking to begin in a particular style
- Level 4 = Formal for-credit course for Grades 9-12
- Level 5 = Opportunities for advanced training, open to Grades 9-12.

Many families choose TVS Dance because our instructors work flexibly with student schedules. We balance the rigor of TVS Dance with that of students' school-day curriculum. Dancers are allowed to participate at their own level of interest, desire, and availability.

Each semester, we showcase dancer progress through a Winter Performance (December) and a Spring Performance (April). We invite families and their quests to enjoy these evenings of fun!

# Trinity Valley School Auxiliary Programs

Vision Statement

In keeping with the mission and philosophy of Trinity Valley School, our Auxiliary Programs exist to develop our students' wide constructive interests by expanding and enriching their academic, creative, and athletic horizons. TVS Auxiliary Programs aim to develop upstanding and empathetic leaders by building authentic partnerships with the Fort Worth community, creating meaningful opportunities for TVS faculty and students to learn and serve, and co-constructing solutions to needs in the community.

### - General Information -

TVS Dance offers a comprehensive dance education for all ages and skill levels. The School offers dance classes in a variety of forms, including...

### **BALLET**

Ballet is the essential foundation of all dance training and enhances dancer strength and flexibility. The study of ballet is strongly recommended for all dancers at every level. Proper technique and alignment are emphasized in the TVS program. Age- and level-appropriate instruction includes barre, center and floor work, choreography, stage presence, and performance etiquette. Pointe work is optional and may begin with the recommendation of the instructor.

### **JAZZ**

Filled with high energy and rhythmic movement, jazz training develops the dancer's range of style, line, and form. Center and floor work, progressions, jumps, turns, and choreography provide a solid foundation in classic and current trends in jazz technique. Dancers experiment with self-expression, develop personal style, and focus on performance quality.

### **LYRICAL**

The study of lyrical joins elements of jazz, modern dance, and ballet technique through expressive dance narratives. Through the study of lyrical, dancers refine balance, increase extension, and connect physical movement with emotional expression. In addition to improvisation, classes consist of center and floor work, progressions, jumps, turns, and choreography.

### HIP HOP

Hip hop's urban street flair combines break dance, pop and lock, freestyle, and tricks. Fun and high energy, hip hop reinforces musicality and a heightened sense of rhythm, self-confidence, expressive movement, and personal style. Dancers gain strength, flexibility, precision of movement, and stamina during this fun and upbeat class with age-appropriate music and choreography.

Our TVS Dance programs mostly fall within the same model as our other Enrichment programs here at Trinity Valley School. As such, many of these logistics – especially for grades PreK-8 – replicate what can be found in our Enrichment Catalogs!

PreK Dance, Kinder Dance, and Levels 1-3 in each style begin after Labor Day for the fall semester and after Martin Luther King, Jr. Day for the spring semester.

- Please pay special attention to the specific dates of the programs.
- If you see an expected date "missing," this indicates either a no-school day OR a day the instructor is unavailable.

Registration for PreK Dance, Kinder Dance, and Levels 1-3 in each style will occur online, via the <u>Auxiliary Programs</u> registration platform, powered by CampBrain. Registration for the fall semester opens on **Wednesday**, **July 17, 2024**, at 5:00 p.m. Registration for the spring semester opens on **Wednesday**, **November 8, 2024**, at 5:00 p.m. All participants – both from Trinity Valley School and the community – must register online.

Due to our Studio's capacity, TVS Dance programs have an enrollment cap.

- If a maximum enrollment is exceeded, our platform will automatically switch the program status to "waitlisting." You are welcome to add your child's name to the waitlist, or find other programs that are still open.
- If space opens in a waitlisted program, a member of the Auxiliary Programs team will contact you as soon as
  possible to inquire about finalizing enrollment. Please note that we may not be able to accommodate all
  waitlisted individuals.

For grades PreK-4, a 15-minute supervised break for restroom, water, and snack (provided) will occur in the TVS Dining Hall between school-day dismissal and the start of TVS Dance programs. This is also the time to change into appropriate attire (please see below). For grades 5-8, programming will typically begin at 4:45, to accommodate other after-school activities – like sports – that participants may have. Students in these grades should report directly to the TVS Dance Studio by the start of their program.

# \*UPPER SCHOOL DANCE I-IV COURSES (OPEN TO STUDENTS IN GRADES 9-12)

The TVS Dance instructors are thrilled to offer formal Upper School courses to interested students. These courses may be taken in fulfillment of certain graduation requirements. (Please contact the Upper School Administration for more information.) Descriptions from the 2024-2025 TVS Upper School Course Catalog may be found here:

### Dance I

This course introduces students to multiple dance forms including ballet, jazz, and, lyrical Ballet is the essential foundation of dance training. Proper technique and alignment are emphasized, and dancers build strength and flexibility. Other prominent dance forms serve to develop the dancer's range of style and expression, connection of movement and form, and heighten rhythm and musicality. Students participate in performance and leadership opportunities throughout the year. For an additional fee, interested students may choose to participate in the extracurricular competitive performance program and attend area dance conventions.

### Dance II

This course expands on the curriculum presented in Dance I. Students further develop their technique, strength, and flexibility through the continued study of ballet jazz, and,lyrical. Increased emphasis is placed on proper alignment, style and expression, connection of movement, and musicality. Students participate in performance and leadership opportunities throughout the year. For an additional fee, interested students may choose to participate in the extracurricular competitive performance program and attend area dance conventions.

Dance III is an advanced course that provides elite-level training to experienced dancers. Students must demonstrate a strong work ethic and commitment to improving their technique at the advanced level. Students participate in performance and leadership opportunities throughout the year. For an additional fee, interested students may choose to participate in the extracurricular competitive performance program and attend area dance conventions.

# LEVEL 5 (for grades 9-12)

Trinity Valley School recognizes that certain dancers in Grades 9-12 may wish for **more advanced and specialized training opportunities** in dance than offered by our Level 4 for-credit course (Upper School). As such, our TVS Dance instructional staff has organized opportunities for students in Grades 9-12 to continue their journey as dancers and pursue excellence in their craft!

### - 2024-2025 Athletic Credit Information -

For students in grades 7-12, work in certain after-school programs may provide fulfillment of the Middle School or Upper School athletic requirements.

### **GRADES 7-8**

A minimum of 6 hours per week with TVS Dance after-school programs is required to fulfill the Middle School athletic requirement.

Although other "pathways" may be provided at the discretion of TVS Dance and the TVS Middle School, the most common "pathway" is:

- 5 hours of Level 3 Ballet, Lyrical, and / or Jazz (note that 6.25 hours of Level 3 classes are offered per week)
- 1 hour of leadership in a lower-level Dance class

OR

A minimum of two consecutive athletic seasons (fall / winter or winter / spring) with TVS Dance is required; the third season may include participation in a TVS sport or in an independent sport with approval from the Athletics Department.

### **GRADES 9-12**

Athletic credit falls under the umbrella of the Upper School Activities Credit requirement. The two common "pathways" for earning Activity Credits (with a physical component) are:

One full semester of participation in the TVS Level 5 after-school program = 1 Activity Credit

Please note that this option requires registration through TVS Auxiliary Programs and is a 2 evening / week commitment.

No credit is awarded for the private Saturday rehearsals; those are truly optional. One full year of enrollment in a Dance I, II, III, or IV course = 3 Activity Credits OR 1 Fine Arts Credit

Please note that enrollment in the course is semester-based, but one Activity Credit is awarded for EACH athletic season of enrollment (fall, winter, and spring).

One full semester of participation in two TVS Level 3 after-school programs = 1 Activity Credit

Please note that this option requires permission from TVS Dance instructors and direct registration via email through the Director of Auxiliary Programs. A 2 evening / week minimum commitment is required.

OR

This option is available to Upper School dancers who wish to participate in after-school dance but may not feel prepared for the Level 5 program.

Any student wishing to fulfill the Middle School or Upper School athletic requirements through participation in TVS Dance must receive advance approval from the administration in the appropriate division.
