



Attendance Matters At Fairport Schools

Fairport Harbor School District has been implementing curriculum updates in math and reading and is focused on helping our students reach their full potential academically and socially. Our students need to be at school to receive instruction and should be well rested. Breakfast and lunch are FREE to all students this year, and we encourage all students to eat a healthy breakfast and lunch.

Parents, we need your help getting students to school every day on time daily.

If your student is absent, you should notify the building secretary or enter the student's absence into the IC attendance request processor.

We are following Ohio State Law and School Board Policy for the excusal of absences. When reporting an absence—whether by phone, email, or the attendance request processor—be sure to include the reason for the absence. Medically excused absences will only be granted with a doctor's note (i.e, from an orthodontist, doctor, urgent care, or hospital).

- Absences not excusable by Ohio Law or Board Policy will be marked as unexcused and counted towards HB410 truancy minutes.
- Tardy arrivals are unexcused and will be counted towards truancy minutes.
- Vacations are unexcused absences and will be counted towards truancy minutes.
- Hair cuts, driving school, and "student just doesn't want to come to school," are unexcused and will be counted towards truancy minutes.
- Lack of transportation is an unexcused absence and will be counted towards truancy minutes.

If you have any questions about excused or unexcused absences, please contact your building principal or secretary. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our attendance records accurate.
