Students are strongly encouraged to utilize the district-provided bus transportation to and from school. Driving to school is a **privilege not a right**. Failure to follow Lakeview High School Student Driving Guidelines will result in temporary or permanent loss of driving privileges. The school district assumes no responsibility for student safety or for personal property damages. Driving privileges are limited to those 16 years old or above who possess a valid Pennsylvania driver's license



(not a PA Learners' Permit) and who agree to the student driving regulations. The number of driving permits issued each school year will not exceed the number of available parking spaces. Detailed information concerning student driving, student riders and loss of driving/riding privileges is available on the Middle-High School website.

Entering Campus

- Student drivers will be assigned a numbered parking permit.
- Please be sure to buckle safety belts, remove ear buds, ignore cell phones/devices, and maintain an appropriate and safe speed at all times.
- Student drivers must proceed immediately to student parking lot upon entering the campus.
- Student drivers and any passengers must exit the vehicle and enter the school, via the entrance on School Road nearest Oakview, as soon as the vehicle is parked.
- ALL students must enter the student parking lot through the entrance nearest Oakview in the gravel lot (including Seniors).
- Student drivers must yield to school buses.
- Student drivers should arrive at LM-HS by 7:50 a.m.

Exiting Campus

- Student drivers will be dismissed at 3:00 p.m. and must follow the designated exiting traffic route. Student drivers are not to exit the parking lot onto School Road, as it disrupts bus travel and creates a safety hazard.
- Students may exit via School Road after the buses have cleared the Oakview campus.
- Student drivers must yield to school buses.
- Safety Check: Please be sure to buckle safety belts, remove earbuds, ignore cell phones/devices, and maintain an appropriate and safe speed at all times.

Parking

Students who drive a motor vehicle to school must know and obey the following rules:

- Each student must register his/her vehicle each school year. Registration forms may be obtained in the office. Each student must display a parking permit for the current year in the designated place on their vehicle in plain view.
 - Vehicles not displaying a valid permit will be subject to consequences. Repeat offenders will receive Level II discipline consequences and risk loss of their parking permit.
 - ✓ Habitual offenders will be referred to School Police Officer.
 - ✓ Drivers may receive a parking ticket and/or be towed at the owner's expense.
- 2. Parking Permits are non-transferable and may be used only by the student to which the permit is assigned.
- 3. Student must notify the office of any changes of the vehicle driven by the students prior to driving it to school and utilizing the student parking lot.
- 4. Students may not enter the parking lot during the school day unless permission has been obtained from the office and a faculty member accompanies them.
- 5. Each student must park in the student area. Violators may be towed away at their own expense.
- Driving from the school grounds during school hours without permission is prohibited. 6.
- Students must leave their vehicles immediately upon arrival at school. 7.
- Sitting in a vehicle during the school day is not permitted. 8.
- 9. Speeding (in excess of 10 mph) or careless driving on the school grounds is not permitted.
- No student driver may take a student with them without school and parent permission. 10.
- All vehicles on the school campus are subject to be searched by the school administration. 11.
- Students may not move their vehicles to other parking areas until after 4:00 PM. 12.
- 13. Students are not permitted to drive personal vehicles to or from school sponsored field trips, athletic practices/competitions, or any other school sponsored event. Students must ride the transportation arranged by the district.
- 14. Student drivers may not cause unnecessary noise (i.e. repeatedly engaging their horn in nonemergency situations, playing loud music, revving their engines).

A student's driving privileges may be revoked for violations of the above rules and/or other appropriate disciplinary actions may be taken, as outlined in the disciplinary code
