Crisis Plan Review/Approval	<p>The crisis plan was presented for review and approval. This plan contains the procedures for safety and security of the students and staff in various types of crises. A motion was made and passed to approve the crisis plan as presented.</p>
Facilities Use Request	<p>A facilities use request for community basketball was presented for approval every Sunday through July 2025 from 7:00 – 9:30 p.m. This group had used the facilities in the past for basketball games on the weekends. This request requires Board approval since it is for Sundays. A motion was made and passed to approve the facilities use request as presented.</p>
Other	<p>At the last Board meeting, one of the Board members resigned her position. By law, the Board was required to advertise that position and fill the vacancy in a way they see fit within 30 days. The Board elected to accept applications through noon today for the Town of Geneva district. Rhoda Briggs has applied for the open seat on the Board. The Board can make a decision to appoint or table this until the next Board meeting (still within the next 30 days). Rhonda was asked questions regarding her vision of the school, why she chose to apply for the vacancy, and some of the areas she sees as shining stars and areas of improvement for South Adams. Arlene Amstutz recommended approval of Rhonda Briggs as the new School Board member for the Town of Geneva district. A motion was made and passed to accept the nomination of Rhonda Briggs for the Town of Geneva vacant seat on the School Board.</p>
