

ATTENDANCE POLICIES

- After five (5) absences, a letter is sent home to make sure that your parent/guardian is aware of your absences.
- After 10 absences, a second letter is sent home to make sure that your parent/guardian is aware of your excessive absences, and a student meeting will be scheduled with Guidance.
- After 15 absences, a letter is sent home to your parent/guardian, and you will be required to sign an attendance contract. This contract outlines the requirements for you to maintain academic progress and satisfactory attendance.
- If additional absences occur, resulting in 20 absences, and the attendance contract is not followed, you will be required to follow the procedure for a "Student Request for an Attendance Committee Hearing." You may be subject to additional disciplinary action and/or not allowed to return to Nassau BOCES.
- A minimum attendance rate of 65% is required for a numerical grade calculation.



WITHDRAWALS

Please return withdrawals with date and signatures as soon as you receive it. It is time sensitive.

New Students or **Returning Students** who have decided not to attend RSIP programs for the new school year, please complete a withdrawal and forward to RSIP building (BT, GCTECH & LIHSA) within the <u>first week of school open</u>. Starting 2nd week of school, students will be on the billing cycle.

HEALTH SCIENCE REQUIREMENTS

- Students in a health science programs will participate in a required clinical rotation at an in-patient healthcare facility. This experience will provide them with the opportunity to practice their skills and make decisions about their future careers.
- A complete physical exam and vaccinations are required by the health care facilities for a student to attend clinic. Therefore, under no circumstances will a student participate in the clinical rotation without a completed health physical and proof of vaccination on file that was done within the year prior to the start of clinic. Students who do not submit a complete physical and proof of vaccination will not be able to complete their program.
- Please note, as per the New York State Department of Education, "students may not be enrolled with the intent to omit portions of a required curriculum which include; in-person skills lab and in-person hands-on clinical at a work-related facility.

Therefore, if a student is not eligible to attend clinic, they will be required to withdraw from the program.





HEALTH SCIENCE REQUIREMENTS (CONT.)

- Students currently enrolled in GC Tech's EMT Program <u>are</u> required to be vaccinated against COVID-19 as per the Nassau Country EMS Academy.
- Students enrolled in all other Health Science programs (Dental Assisting, Health Care Skills, Medical Assisting and Nurse Assisting) <u>are NOT</u> required to have the COVID-19 vaccine to participate in their clinical rotation at NUMC at this time.
- Vaccination requirements are subject to change. As always, we will communicate any changes to families in a timely manner

CTE Programs @ Career Preparatory High School

- * Career Explorations Program (2-Year Program)
- Office Skills (2-Year Program)

- Student will earn 3 Elective credits per year
- Students will earn the CDOS Credential after the complete the two-year program (Possibly one year in Office Skills)

How do we apply for this program?

Apply to Barry Tech as with any other program on the portal with all necessary documents.

You can choose Career Explorations as your first or second choice (or both)

If a student applies for other programs and are not accepted, they may then be referred to our Career Explorations program.

We will then contact the person that did the application from the district to set up a screening.

We are currently doing screenings in person with the parent/guardian. District representatives may also attend the screening to see the program as well.

Frequently ask questions:

Do our kids go on buses with CPHS Students – Yes sometimes

Do our students hand in phones/get wanded like CPHS students? – yes school policy

Do the students earn WBLH? Work in progress since this is our first year. We will have a better idea of about how many at the conclusion of the program this year.

Do you offer any other academic or PE credit? No not at this time.




- Students are in class with the CTE teacher, a CTE teacher aide,
 a Special Education teacher &
 2 teacher aides.
- Students begin the day in a homeroom with the special Ed teacher
- Students are escorted to the next class as a group
- They take each class for a full period each (Office Skills is different)
- AM session 8:00-10:20
- PM session 11:30-1:50
- 1:1s from the district are welcome to come with the student.

The Career Explorations Program is a twoyear program that provides students with a dynamic and immersive experience in Automotive Skills, Wood Technology, and Food Services. This comprehensive program allows students to delve into these three diverse fields, gaining practical knowledge and hands on experience that can pave the way for future career opportunities.

The students attend either an AM or PM session. In each session, the students attend each of these classes over 3 periods daily. The hours for the AM session are 8:00 AM -10:30 am and the PM session are 11:30 AM-1:50 PM.









Course Description: The Office Skills Program is a two-year comprehensive program designed to introduce students to the fundamentals of office skills while incorporating an introduction to different business principles. This program aims to equip students with the necessary knowledge and practical skills required to excel in an office environment. Through a combination of interactive lectures, hands-on activities, and task assignments, students will develop a solid foundation in both business concepts and essential office skills.
