Forms of Academic Assessments	Yarbrough Elementary administers common formative assessments in all subjects after unit instruction throughout the year. No matter the teacher, each child is assessed via the assessment provided by the designated curriculum as well as the Midland ISD Teaching & Learning department. Students receive Beginning of Year, Middle of Year, and End of Year to check on their growth progress and to see where they are preforming. Parents will receive copies of this information. These assessments are modeled after the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness, or STAAR tests. Previous STAAR tests are released which are utilized for assessment and instruction in addition to other curriculums.
