The Community

SOAR High School is part of the Antelope Valley Union High School District (AVUHSD). The Antelope Valley Union High School District serves 22,065 students in the cities of Lancaster and Palmdale, as well as the surrounding areas. The attendance area of SOAR High School is equivalent to that of the district and covers approximately 1,200 square miles which accounts for at least 45% of the landmass of Los Angeles County. Students come from all over the attendance area.

The School

Celebrating 18 years

SOAR High School (SHS) has two campuses in the Antelope Valley, which is part of the high desert of Southern California, within the boundaries of Los Angeles County. SHS (Lancaster Campus) was established in 2006 and is housed on the Antelope Valley College (AVC) campus. SHS (Palmdale Campus) is located in Palmdale and students take college classes at AVC's Palmdale Campus. SHS is an early college high school with a STEM focus and full AVID program with the aim of removing financial and other barriers to higher education.

Curriculum

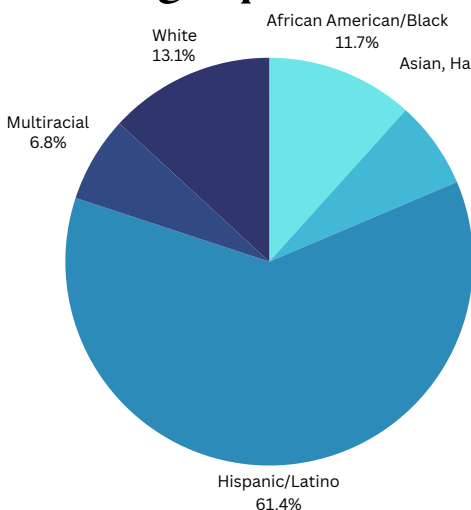
Curriculum consists of a combination of A-G high school required classes and transferable college classes. Visual and Performing Arts and Foreign Language are two of the A-G required subject requirements taken at Antelope Valley College. Students continue taking college classes to complete an Associates' Degree and/or complete IGETC requirements.

Generally, each student is enrolled in four to six high school classes and approximately one to four college classes per semester. The minimum requirement to attend is one academic college course per semester and no more than 11 total units in the Fall or Spring terms. All 9-12th grade students are on the high school campus daily. Students take their college classes on days and hours they are not attending high school. Students take their college classes on the college campus.

College Enrollment Limitations*

California State law limits full-time high school students to a maximum of 11 college units per term.

Accreditation

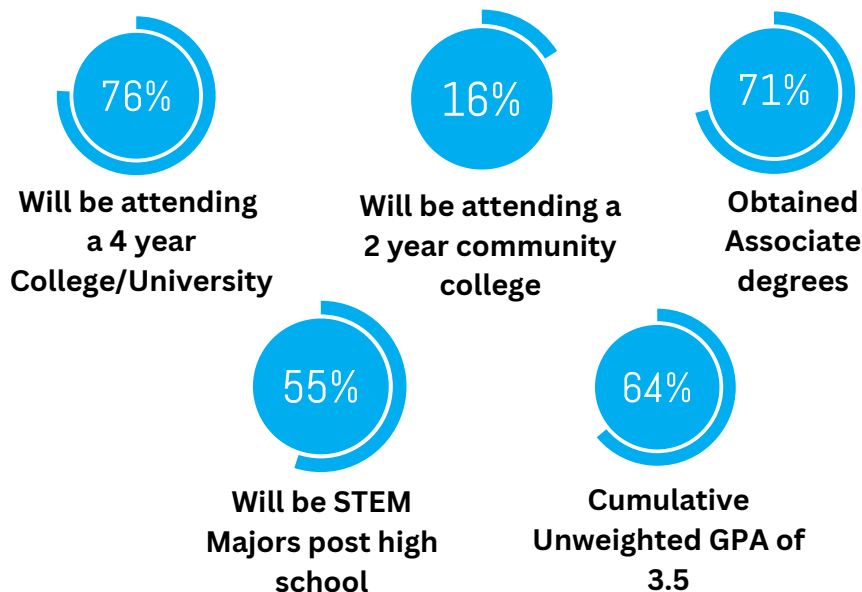
SOAR High School received a six-year accreditation from 2024 through 2030 from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).
