

DROP OFF AND PICK UP SAFETY GUIDELINES AM DROP OFF: DOORS OPEN: 9:05 AM PULL UP: AS FAR AS POSSIBLE ON THE CURB.

CHILD READINESS: HAVE YOUR CHILD READY AND UNBUCKLED ON THE PASSENGER SIDE.

IN-CAR: DO NOT EXIT YOUR VEHICLE OR GET OUT TO SAY GOODBYE. TRAFFIC FLOW: DO NOT PULL AHEAD OF OTHER CARS AFTER YOUR CHILD EXITS. THIS CAN CREATE TRAFFIC ISSUES AND SAFETY HAZARDS WITH ONCOMING TRAFFIC.

PM PICK UP:

PICK UP LOCATION: IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL ALONG THE CURB.

SCHOOL ENDS: 3:50 PM; STUDENTS BEGIN EXITING AT 3:40 PM.

IN-CAR: REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE AND DISPLAY YOUR CAR TAG.

PULL UP: AS FAR AS POSSIBLE ON THE CURB.

IN-CAR: DO NOT GET OUT OF YOUR VEHICLE OR OPEN THE DOOR FOR YOUR CHILD. STUDENT ENTRY: ENSURE YOUR CHILD ENTERS THE VEHICLE FROM THE CURB (PASSENGER SIDE).

TRAFFIC FLOW: DO NOT PULL AHEAD OF OTHER CARS AFTER YOUR CHILD ENTERS. THIS CAN CAUSE CONGESTION AND SAFETY ISSUES WITH ONCOMING TRAFFIC. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

BUCKLING ASSISTANCE: IF YOU NEED TO ASSIST WITH BUCKLING, PLEASE PULL AHEAD TO THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE STREET NEAR MEMORIAL PARK.

CAR TAGS: CONTACT THE LODL OFFICE IF YOU NEED A CAR TAG.

PICK UP TIME: ENSURE YOUR CHILD IS PICKED UP BY 3:55 PM.
