 - describe the character's traits, feelings, and behaviors in a story
 - describe the setting of a narrative using text evidence

The student can:

- Identify the main story elements in a literary text read independently:
 - character
 - setting
 - plot(beginning, middle, end)
- Demonstrate listening skills by answering questions about texts read aloud
