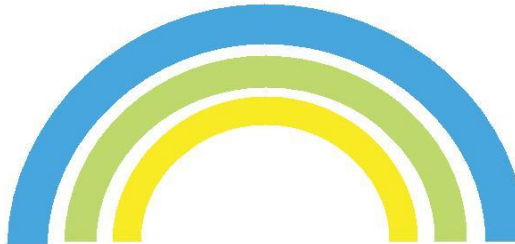

## HIGHLIGHTS

There are a limited number of American host family homestays available to Senior Division students, either for four weeks or one weekend. Host Families provide basic room and board and involvement as a member of the family, not as a formal guest. Students enjoy the homestay experience by learning about American culture, taking part in daily life and have ample opportunity to practice English.

Senior Division Students may also reside with a parent/guardian.

Participants are responsible for: International travel expenses to and from Hawaii, travel documents (visa, passport, etc.), health/accident insurance (required), daily transportation to and from school, and housing. Students will also be expected to have sufficient spending money to cover personal expenses, emergency expenditures and any debts incurred while in the U.S.
