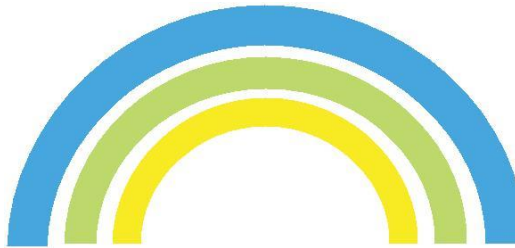

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Beginning, intermediate and advanced English language students, ages 5 to 18
