If your student is in the Career Programme, the Diploma Programme or the IB certificate, or any of our DP courses, they will be taking at least one DP exam this spring. The district pays for all exam fees for all DP students.

Sitting the **IB exams** in the spring is **10% of their local course grade** in PowerSchool. If a student misses any portion of their IB exam, it will affect their final grade in the class.

The **IB Diploma Programme Exam window is APRIL 28-MAY 21 2025**  
These are worldwide exams that **cannot** be rescheduled.

**Results** come out in the first week of July. Students will receive their personal code and PIN in May so that they may check their results online.

**If your student wants their results sent to a college or university they must request that by the end of May via google form on the CHS website.**

Official results and certificates from the IB will be mailed home in September/October.

# What to Expect at Graduation

May 30th, 2025  
6pm in the Stadium  
Ceremony will be broadcast



## Graduation Day Schedule

7:30am - Senior Breakfast in the cafeteria

9 am - Practice (all students must attend)

5pm- Students Meet in the auxiliary gym

6pm- Graduation Ceremony will begin

After the Ceremony - Students will return to the Aux Gym to pick up their diploma. If they have borrowed a cap and gown, it will need to be returned when they get their diploma. If fees need to be paid or items returned the school will be open the following week.

## The Expectations/Rules

- ★ Students must meet all graduation requirement to participate in the ceremony.
- ★ All students must have a cap and gown to be in the ceremony - They may purchase from Herff Jones or they can sign up this fall to borrow one from the Counseling office
- ★ Caps are not allowed to be decorated
- ★ Stols of cultural significance are allowed
- ★ Students with fines may participate in the ceremony however they will not be allowed to pick up their diploma until fines are paid and any borrowed cap and gowns are returned.
- ★ Students will receive 6 GA tickets. Every guest who attends graduation must have a ticket. No in and out privileges.
- ★ No balloons or air-horns/noise makers will be allowed in the stadium.
- ★ More tickets may become available ... Look for an email in May.
- ★ Parents or guests will be allowed on the field for 30 minutes after the ceremony.

# SAT/ ACT TEST SCORES

- Most Colleges are Test
- Optional & **Not Required for Admission.** including the UCs, CSUs, HBCUs
- SAT/ ACT Scores if submitted are used as course placements.
- SAT/ACT Scores can be useful for Merit Based Scholarships & Ivy League Schools but in the majority of cases are not **Required.**

- Currently, application will be available on **December 1, 2024**
- 2025-2026 DEADLINE, the state priority deadline is **March 3, 2025** ~~
  - Deadline might change~~
- Rancho Cordova Promise Program is a separate application, but only available to Rancho Cordova Residents & it opens next semester for students attending Folsom Lake College. [Link](#)

**Very important:**

**ALL students must fill out the FAFSA or CADAA to get the Promise program or any other financial aid!**





# State Seal of Biliteracy

The state seal of biliteracy is an award given to graduating high school students who have studied and attained proficiency in English and one or more languages.

## Eligibility:

### 1: Demonstrates English proficiency through ONE of the following methods:

- Complete all English arts for graduation requirements with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or above in those classes.
- Pass California standards assessment at the “Standards Met” or above in English language arts at the 11th grade.
- Score 480 on SAT

### 2: Demonstrates proficiency in one or more languages in addition to English proficiency through ONE of the following:

- Successfully complete a four-year course of study in a world language and attain an overall grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- Score at the proficient level or higher on a district exam through speaking, reading and writing.

## Los Rios Community College Promise Program

- Covers the cost of tuition, up to 15 units  
-Does not covered Health, Student Representation Fees, Books, Transportation, or Living Expenses
- Enroll in at least 12 units by the [deadline](#)
- Maintain a 2.0GPA
- Two Award Years
- No Income Requirement

## Rancho Cordova Promise Program

- Must be Resident from Rancho Cordova
- Separate Application within application period: [Link](#)
- Must enroll in at least 6 units at FLC
- Must pass a minimum of 6 units with C or better
- Up to \$886 for up to 4 semesters”:.  
-Tuition/enrollment fees, health services fee, students representation fee, & universal transit pass.
