

Attention 3rd-5th Grade Families

Dear families of our third though fifth grade Challengers,

We thank you and your family for being our valued partners as we work together to educate our students at Mariposa. As you may already be aware, building our social-emotional learning skills is an important goal of ours. At the beginning of the school year, we asked for your permission to have students participate in a social emotional learning survey. If we have consent for a student to participate, they will complete a survey designed to provide school staff data on students' understanding of concepts related to Harmony, which is the social-emotional learning curriculum we are implementing with our students.

The survey content will ask students to self-reflect on Emotion Regulation, Self-Efficacy, Sense of Belonging, and Teacher-Student Relationships. These topics are related to the content in Sanford Harmony and will help guide the implementation of the curriculum and measure its impact over time. The online survey will take place between August 29th and September 4th. It will be completed at school and should not take more than 20-30 minutes to complete.

Student responses will provide invaluable insights into their experiences and how we can improve and adapt our school to their needs. If a student doesn't feel like they have enough information to answer a question, they will be able to skip the item altogether. The responses to these surveys will be completely confidential.


