Program Details:

- Program will start September 3rd and run all school year.
- We will meet in the Fairless Middle School tutoring room.
- Our program will run 2:40–4:15 on Tuesdays.
- Middle school students only (6th–8th grade).
- Every staff member of our program will have undergone a background check, finger printing, and training to work with children.

What We'll Be Doing:

- We will provide your child with homework help, a snack, recreational games, and a Bible study.
- We will have occasional events hosted by Reformation Bible Church in Beach City that your child can attend.
- We will also have small group discussions with the students after our study where your child will be able to communicate more about what was discussed during the lesson.

Need to Know:

- Your child must have a permission slip filled out to be enrolled in the program. Medical information must be provided for your child to be enrolled.
- Your child can be enrolled by filling out the last page of this form and returning it to the school office or to Next Gen staff.
- We will take attendance each week before we start the program.
- If your child will not be in attendance for that day, please notify Tim McLaughlin (330-770-1172) or Nick Abraham (330-324-2716). It is you or your child's responsibility to notify us when your child will be absent.
- We will contact you in case of cancellation.
- Your child must adhere to the rules as presented by Next Gen staff, which are in connection with the school's code of conduct. Failure to adhere to the rules or failure to be respectful to staff and other students will require you to be contacted and may result in your child needing picked up from the program early.
- Your child will be expected to bring their homework to the program, but they will not be forced to work on it past the allotted time given for homework (20 minutes).
- Your child will be participating in a study taught out of the Bible; Bibles will be provided to each student enrolled in the program.
- Your child is required to have his/her legal guardian information on file and an additional contact person so that proper communication can be established.
- Your child may also be included in pictures posted online for the Next Gen website and social media.
