SENIORS:

- For Seniors, the beginning of the school year also means we need to start thinking about next year! Mrs. Meis and Mrs. Bunton spent the last few days with Senior English classes discussing options for after high school and have also begun meeting with ALL seniors individually for their Senior Check-In Meeting. A typical day at Wyoming High School:

Below you will find information about what a typical day looks like at WHS. Please consider reviewing this information with your student and reach out if you have any questions. Thank you.

- **WHS Main Office Hours:** WHS Office Hours are Monday-Friday 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- **Arrival:** We will open the doors for students daily at 7:40 a.m.
- **School Hours:** Our school day runs between 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- **Tardy Bell:** The tardy bell rings to start the day at 8:00 a.m.
- **Flex:** Flex days will be on Tuesday and Thursday
- **Cell Phones:** All student cell phones must be placed in the teacher designated area during academic times (i.e., instructional class periods and study halls). Students are permitted to have phones during Flex, in the hallways during class changes and in the cafeteria during lunch.
- **Updated Schedules:** All students received an updated schedule on Wednesday, August 14th. Our counselors are working diligently to process any recent requests. Thank you for your patience.
- **Student Drivers:** Drive safely and only park in a lot if a pass has been purchased and displayed.
