	211. STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE
s 511 (f)	The Board recognizes the need for insurance coverage for the unforeseen accidents which may occur to students in the course of attendance at school or student participation in the athletic and extra-curricular programs at the schools.
	The Board will maintain insurance coverage by a qualified insurer over and above the first responsibility of family coverage and at no cost to the student for injury resulting from accidents sustained in the course of participation in an interscholastic sports program, in the cheerleading program and in the band program.
	The Board will provide parents the opportunity to purchase insurance coverage, at no cost to the Board, for injury resulting from accidents sustained by students in an intramural sports program, in the program of physical education or in any activity in school, on school grounds, on a school bus or at an activity sponsored by the school (including driver education training.)
	 The Superintendent shall: Prepare specifications and secure suitable coverage from qualified insurance carriers for recommendation and Board consideration. Notify all students and parents of students who may be eligible for insurance. Ascertain that – where the Board assumes the full cost of the insurance – each eligible student is properly insured.
