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	224 Care of School Property
	The Board believes that the schools should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.
	The Board charges each student in the schools of this district with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.
Sec. 777	Students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians of students shall be held accountable for the student actions.
Sec. 1338	The Board may report to the appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property has been serious or chronic in nature.
	In no case shall such referral to juvenile authorities be made without prior notification to the student's parent or guardian.
Sec. 801	The Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include:
Sec. 109, 777, 801, 1338	Rules for the safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies, and equipment;
	2. Preparation of a schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies and equipment;
	3. And a report to the Board on occurrence on the incidence of vandalism.
