	237. ELECTRONIC DEVICES
<p>1. Authority SC 1317.1</p> <p>SC 510</p> <p>Pol. 815</p>	<p>The Board prohibits possession of laser pointers and attachments and telephone paging devices/beepers by students on school property, on buses and other vehicles provided by the district, and at school sponsored activities.</p> <p>The Board prohibits use of personal communication devices by students during the school day in district buildings, on district property, and while students are attending school sponsored activities, and during instructional time.</p> <p>In addition, the Board prohibits possession and use by students of any device that provides for a wireless, unfiltered connection to the Internet during the school day in district buildings.</p> <p>The district shall not be liable for the loss, damage or misuse of any electronic device brought to school by a student.</p>
<p>2. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall annually notify students, parents/guardians and staff about the district's electronic device policy by publishing such policy in the student handbook, newsletters, posted notices, and other efficient methods.</p>
<p>3. Guidelines Pol. 218, 233</p> <p>SC 1317.1</p>	<p>Violations of this policy by a student shall result in disciplinary action and may result in confiscation of the electronic device. The confiscated item shall not be returned until a conference has been held with a parent/guardian</p> <p><u>Telephone Pagers/Beepers</u></p> <p>With prior administrative approval, the telephone paging device/beeper prohibition shall not apply in the following cases:</p> <p>1. A student who is a member of a volunteer fire company, ambulance or rescue squad.</p>
