



LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP COMMON APPLICATION

DEADLINE TO APPLY IS MAY 1

Multiple local scholarships within one application. Some scholarships will require a brief interview. Interviews to be held at the high school on Wednesday May 15 so plan your work schedule accordingly.

APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE IN THE GUIDANCE OFFICE

Bennett J. Palmer Sr. Memorial Scholarship: One \$500 scholarship to one Holland graduating senior pursuing further education at a 2-year college, 4-year college or technical school. Financial need is not necessary. Agricultural background is preferred but not necessary. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships.

Frank H. Brink- American Legion Post #607: The Legion will award one \$1000 scholarship to a Holland senior in good academic standing who is planning to attend a technical, trade school, 2-year or 4-year college. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships.

Holland Alumni Association Scholarship: Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded based upon achievement in academics, attendance, and participation in activities, service and financial need. An additional \$1000 scholarship "In Memory of Kenneth Tanner" will be awarded to an art student. Applicants must be attending a 2- or 4-year college/technical school. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

Holland PTO Scholarship: Two \$500 scholarships. Applicant must be accepted to an institute of higher learning (trade school, 2-year or 4-year college). Awards based upon community service, leadership, dependability, and hard work in school. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

Holland Teachers' Association: Nora Kanner Scholarship: \$1000 -Applicant must be planning to pursue a Bachelor's or Associates degree. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

Holland Teachers' Association: James D. Tanner Scholarship: \$1000- Applicant must have a three-year cumulative average of 90% or above and obtain recommendations from two sources. Financial need is **not** a requirement. Applicant must be planning to pursue a Bachelor's or Associates degree. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

Holland Teachers' Association-Teamster Scholarship: \$1000- Applicant must be planning to pursue a Bachelor's or Associates degree. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

Ken Tanner Memorial Scholarship - (Holland Rod & Gun Club): One \$1000 scholarship open to a Holland graduating senior pursuing further education at a 2-year college, 4-year college or technical school. **Students of all majors are encouraged to apply.** Preference may be given to students majoring in Environmental Conservation or Wildlife Management. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

Kiwanis Club of Holland Scholarship: Three \$1000 scholarships will be awarded. Applicants must be attending a 2- or 4-year college. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

The Reinhardt Family 4-Year College Scholarship: One \$10,000 (\$2500/year for 4 years) scholarship awarded to a graduating senior with demonstrated financial need and planning to attend an accredited 4-year college or university, regardless of race, sex, religion, color, national origin, or ancestry. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

The Reinhardt Family 2-Year College Scholarship: (A \$2,000 (\$1000/year for 2 years) vocational scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who demonstrates financial need, is industrious, shows tremendous initiative, and is planning to attend a vocational, technical or 2-year college. This is part of the Common Application for Local Scholarships. *(Interview Required).*

One \$1000 scholarship to a graduating senior from Attica, Holland, Iroquois or Pioneer. Must be an Eagle Scout and planning to attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college or technical school.

To be eligible, the applicant MUST be of legal status in the US, a current high school senior expecting to graduate in June who has been accepted to a college or university, have a household income of less than \$55,000 with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 (90)
