School Telemedicine Services

With our school partnership, telemedicine service offered at the school campus. Students have the opportunity to see a provider without leaving school! The school nurse will assist one of our providers with assessment and testing of your child.

Immunizations, Vaccines and Testing

Another service available with the school partnerships is immunizations and vaccines at the school campus. Periodically, the clinic will come to your child's campus to offer immunizations or seasonal vaccines.

Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce Big Spring ISD has partnered with Martin County Family Clinic to create an on campus clinic that allows your child to see a provider if they become ill or have unexpected healthcare needs during the school day. The program is designed to assist families in rural areas to have convenient access to medical care without leaving their campus. This program will be available in the 2023-2024 school year.

Enrollment is necessary if you would like your child to be able to see a Physician or Nurse Practitioner from The Martin County Family Clinic during the school day by telehealth.

Enrollment/Registration – There is no cost to enroll! Some information is necessary to complete the enrollment process. This includes insurance information, address and emergency contact, child's allergies, your pharmacy and a written consent to evaluate your child by telehealth.

Enrollment is easy! Go to the Martin County Hospital website at <https://martincountyhospital.org/> and visit the Family Clinic - Community Outreach Programs. Select the "Enroll Now" option to get started.



You may also scan this code by phone to start the enrollment process

Once enrolled, the parent or guardian will be notified and permission granted before telehealth services are initiated. Parents/guardians can opt out of the program at any time and there is no commitment to see a provider if you do not wish to.

Esto incluye información del seguro, dirección y contacto de emergencia, alergias del niño, su farmacia y un consentimiento por escrito para evaluar a su hijo por telesalud.

Una vez inscrito, se notificará al padre o tutor y se otorgará el permiso antes de que se inicien los servicios de telesalud. Los padres/tutores pueden optar por no participar en el programa en cualquier momento y no hay ningún compromiso de ver a un proveedor si no lo desea.
