Nominations must demonstrate clear evidence of a significant impact on the district and/or the students. Nominations may also be done posthumously.

The Wall of Honor Committee is comprised of various Board members, district employees, and community members. The Committee uses criteria for prospective nominees to the Wall.

Each year the Wall of Honor Committee will consider the nominees and vote on candidates to honor. The honorees will have their pictures and brief biographies hung on the inner back wall of the Beverly Beardsell Auditorium located in the High School auditorium. The future honorees and their family members will be notified when the selection process has been completed. Their induction will be recognized in a gathering on May 21, 2020 at the Holland High School Auditorium.
