The committee then decided to recommend the following options for actions related to spending Smart Schools funds:

- 1) Have library hours open for students, families, and community members for internet use, studying, etc. This could either be at the Jr. Sr. High School or Boys and Girls Club.
- 2) Have community members with school representatives go to the town hall to see if they would be willing to work with Time Warner or someone to get better internet service in this area.
- 3) Replace the Smart Boards with updated touch screens.
- 4) Create charging stations for common areas in the Junior Senior High like the lunch room, library, and band room.
