Evening Prayer

OLGC has a beautiful tradition of sung Evening Prayer the first Monday of every month, September through June. At 7pm, in the Church, all are invited to gather and fulfill Jesus' command to "pray always" (Luke 18:1). Through this prayer we sanctify the day by praising God and offering prayers of intercession for the needs of the world. Evening Prayer gives thanks for the day just passed and makes an evening sacrifice of praise to God. We begin with a hymn, followed by the singing of Psalms, a

scripture reading and reflection, a short responsory is recited, the Canticle of Mary is sung, followed by intercessions, the Lord's Prayer, a concluding prayer and dismissal, and a closing hymn. The service lasts about a half hour and is a peaceful way to give thanks and praise to God as you conclude the first day of the week.

The first Evening Prayer of the season will be on September 9 because of the Labor Day holiday. We hope to see you there.

FYI: MEDICARE VACCINES

The Inflation Reduction Act has succeeded in encouraging more Medicare recipients to be vaccinated, according to data released by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Beginning January 1, 2023, the law eliminated cost-sharing for all recommended adult vaccines covered under Part D. A significant increase was noted in the numbers of Medicare enrollees who received the shingles and T-dap vaccines over recipients in 2021. About 6.5 million received the new RSV vaccines, which were added to the Medicare recommended list last June. (Kiplinger Retirement Report)

THE POWER OF "YES"

Recently I came across a presentation I made in 2013 at OLGC at the request of then-OSFS Deacon, Brian Zumbrum. I spoke of the role of the laity in the life of the church, specifically about liturgical ministry. In preparing the presentation and reflecting on my experiences, I realized that every time I said "yes" to an invitation to serve, my life changed for the better. This was especially true when a priest asked me to be a Eucharistic Minister. My response was "Oh, my gosh, no, I'm not worthy!" To which he responded "Oh Marge, nobody's worthy!" (I said yes.)

All of which brings me to urge you to consider saying "yes" to the recent invitations to join the Liturgical Ministry here at OLGC. If lectoring or distributing Holy Communion are too intimidating for you, there are other places you're sorely needed. Other areas to consider are the Music Ministry, the Altar Guild, Funeral Ministry, Wedding Coordinator, Children's

Vigesimoprimer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, 25 de agosto

En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús nos urge a que sigamos siendo fieles a Él, y a que continuemos viviendo en el "espíritu que nos da la vida". Al respecto San Francisco de Sales dice lo siguiente:

Nuestro Salvador vino al mundo para recrear a la humanidad. Cuando vivimos en el Espíritu de Jesús trascendemos de nuestra vida común y corriente para empezar a vivir una vida más excelsa. 


