XII. Board Comments

Vice-President Angela Raimo reported on a zoom call she had yesterday. It was to have taken place with Congressman Suozzi, however due to his attendance at the Democratic National Convention, the meeting took place with one of his staff members (Brent Katz). Those on the zoom call were updated as to what Suozzi has been working on as well as what school boards would like to see pushed in Congress and things that are important to us. The group would like to meet in person eventually. They discussed the foundation aid formula and how the Rockefeller Institute is giving their recommendations by December 1st, and then the Governor makes a decision. People were saying that the special education formula doesn't take into account student needs. Some students need a lot more services than others and it ends up being more costly. There was communication about bringing the federal funding up to 40%, wasn't sure what that meant. There was a lot of input in this area. Additional conversation included electric buses with the big problem being lack of infrastructure, charging stations, places to keep them as well as district expenses and if they would replace entire fleets or retrofit the engines. It was mentioned if this is going to be a required thing that maybe the government could provide some funding source.

Further discussion was about the Alice Measure which gives a more accurate poverty rate index in communities. The final discussion was regarding e-rate funding which has to do with funding for technology, devices, cyber security, AI, and would like to have more training for teachers. They mentioned that they are afraid that this is an area where there will be cuts and how to preserve this so we have enough support in cyber security and training. This will be an on-going conversation especially in the area of special education.

Dr. Maria Rianna added to the report by stating that she is happy that these conversations are happening at different levels. We also want to change the rate for pre-school reimbursement because it's so low that many of the pre-schools have shut down because they can't afford to run programs. Last year there were around 300 pre-k students who could not acquire appropriate placement. This is not in one region alone, it's in the entire state of New York.
