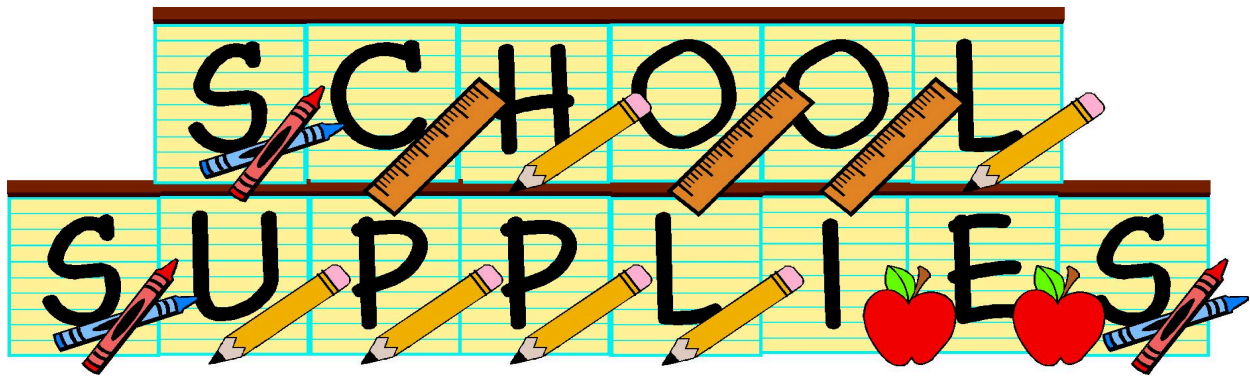

- Standard sized Backpack (large enough to carry a 3 ring folder without it being folded)
- Complete change of clothes (including underwear and socks) in a large zip lock bag to be kept in school bags
- Snack bag (a small bag to keep snack organized and separate from other items in backpack)
- A simple snack to be brought daily (it should include items from 2 different food groups)
- A reusable water bottle to be brought daily
- Toileting items as needed (diapers, pull-ups, wipes no medication or creams)
- 1 box of **CRAYOLA** washable markers 8 pack thin markers\*
- 1 box of **CRAYOLA** washable markers 8 pack large markers\*
- 1 box of **CRAYOLA** crayons 8 pack\*
- 1 box of **CRAYOLA** colored pencils 12 pack\*
- 1 8 oz bottle of **ELMER'S WASHABLE** glue\*
- 2 **ELMER'S** purple glue sticks\*
- 2 boxes of tissues\*
- 2 containers of unscented baby wipes\*
- 1 roll of paper towels\*
- 1 box of ziploc bags\* (Mrs. DiFucci-snack, Mrs. Garrity-sandwich, Mrs. Thomas-gallon)
