ROAR Assessment


Through our partnership with Stanford University, we are excited to share that Howard will administer the ROAR (Rapid Online Assessment of Reading) to all students Sept. 3-5. The ROAR, developed by the Stanford Reading & Dyslexia Research Program, is an ongoing academic research project and online platform for assessing foundational reading skills. The ROAR is a cutting-edge, well-validated assessment tool that will provide the school with valuable data that will better inform individualized instruction to meet our students' needs.
