

St. Agnes Catholic Parish Rectory Project

New Parish Residence for Our Priests and Seminarians

Dear St Agnes Family,

As a Catholic parish, one of our fundamental responsibilities is to provide a safe and suitable residence for the priests who dedicate their lives to serving our community. The current rectory, which has been home to our priests for many years, is now in a state of disrepair that poses serious health and safety concerns. After years of postponement, we have reached a point where we can no longer delay this critical project.

Our parish has grown significantly over the years, and the need for a comfortable, safe and functional residence has become urgent. We must now, not only accommodate our current priests, but also prepare for the possibility of an additional priest in residence as well as hosting seminarians who are training in service to our community. Unfortunately, after extensive evaluations, it has become clear that simple renovations to the existing dwelling will not suffice. The structure no longer meets the necessary Village of Key Biscayne, Miami-Dade and State of Florida building codes, making rebuilding a parish home for our clergy, the only viable option.

This decision was not made lightly. After thorough deliberation and in consultation with the parish council, finance committee, and the Archdiocese of Miami, we have committed to constructing a new residence for our parish. This new home, owned by the Archdiocese of Miami, will meet the essential needs of our clergy and ensure that our priests, now and in the future, have a place to live that is both safe and conducive to their ministry.

We are deeply grateful to the generous donors within our parish who have already committed to supporting this project financially. Their contributions reflect a shared recognition of the importance of this endeavor.

Construction will begin soon, and in the meantime, Fr. JC and Fr. Andrew have temporarily moved to a rented apartment near the church. We understand that this is a significant undertaking, but it is necessary for the continued growth and spiritual well-being of our parish.

Last week our St. Agnes Catholic Parish was so honored to welcome Sister Mary Cecilia from The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG) to speak at our masses about the Catholic sponsored organization's noble mission. The LSMIG are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in in Northern Uganda (East Africa). They serve those recovering from civil war and refugee crises. With limited resources, they are bravely responding to the needs of these people and especially to the refugee child-mothers and their children in the camps through a Catholic Education Center, offering vocational training and daycare to break the cycle of teenage pregnancy and give these girls and their children a brighter future.

Our parish is so blessed to be able to serve and financially support the vast network of Catholic charities in much need of aid such as the LSMIG, through the Archdiocese of Miami.

We are immensely grateful to our St. Agnes community for opening their hearts and giving generously to support the LSMIG programs that help the struggling and impoverished young girls and their children have a better life. It is thanks to your charitable donations, that we were able to collect over \$15,000 to be sent to the Archdiocese of Miami to give to The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu.

"Charity is at the heart of the church, it is the reason for its action, the soul of its mission," said Pope Francis in September 2017 during the feast of St. Vincent de Paul in Rome. Thomas Aquinas said, "the habit of charity extends not only to the love of God but also the love of our neighbor."
