Creative Project Guidelines

What we are looking for when reviewing your Creative Project:

- Project created specifically for the Nueva application (started after September 1).
- Creatively showcasing ONE or at most TWO of your passions.
- There isn't a right answer. We want to get to know you.
- We're not looking for professional quality. However, how you choose to complete your project is up to you and the materials you have.
- Authenticity and curiosity are key.
- This is not the place to give us a mini-introduction to yourself. We get all of that through your other application materials! We're looking for this project to be focused on your passion.
- An explanation for why and how you chose a topic/passion, and why and how you chose the medium (art, song, robot, etc.). This can either be a written piece to accompany your project or woven into your project itself.

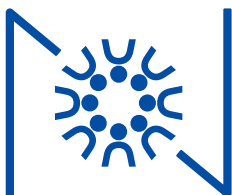
Physical Object: If your project is a physical object, simply snap a picture of your submission and upload it to Ravenna so we can have it on file. Please **do not** mail us your final product. Pictures and descriptions uploaded through Ravenna are sufficient.

Video: If your project is a video, please ensure it does not exceed 3 minutes. Ravenna does not support medium to large sized files, so please upload your content to YouTube, Google Drive, Vimeo, etc. Then, copy and paste the link into a document and upload the document to Ravenna.

Written Piece: If your project is an essay, excerpt from a novel, or other written piece, please ensure it does not exceed 3 pages. Please upload the Word document or PDF to Ravenna.

Multiple Documents: If you need to upload multiple documents, try converting them into PDFs (if they aren't already) and combining them into one cohesive document. Simple instructions for how to do this can be found on Google.
