All students have daily chapel for 20 minutes and are required to take a Bible class. All secondary students have 7 classes per day and spend 45 minutes in each class period.


Upperclassmen can take additional AP courses not offered at Mount Dora Christian Academy through Florida Virtual School. Students may also dual enroll through select university partners.
