

Senior Community Service Information

- Seniors can earn a special cord to wear at graduation if they complete 15 hours of community service between **June 1st and May 1st** of their senior year.
- Community Service Hours are to be documented in the online **Senior Community Service Hours Form** found on the **Graduation** page of the FHS website. Completed forms need to be submitted by **May 1st**.
- Hours performed for other school service organizations (such as National Honor Society, Student Council, Key Club and Students in Action) **will count** toward Senior Community Service hours and need to be documented in the online **Senior Community Service Hours Form** by **May 1st**.
